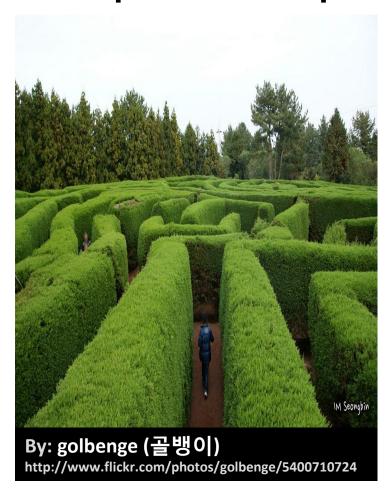

## DIY + Ready-Made = Remix?

Do reused resources fit what you already have?





Remix instead of reuse?

**Read-Write** instead

of **Read-Only**?

(Lessig, 2008)

#### What makes a resource open?

- Access? (is online enough?)
- Cost? (free-of-charge?)
- License (clear intent?)
- Remixable (read-write rather than read-only)?

Openness can focus on CRATIS or LIBRE













Copyright/licensing covers more + economic rights

#### What does it mean?

- At the stage when you are designing you know content is available and any limits to use
- You can get out there and share and learn from what happens to your own resources
- You and your students can remix for more active engagement and collaboration
- Your productive and effective learning can have wider benefit (depending on license)

### Pulling it together in practice

Use OpenStudio so students can share and license items in progress (Seeley-Brown, undated)

Oct 2013: OU module in MA in Online and Distance Education

Online conference open to MA ODE alumni and invited others (restricted-open)

Students decide how open their practice will be within the module (e.g. open licenses)

H818: The Networked Practitioner

Models use of open texts and resources across a range of sources, (e.g. Weller, 2011) Using **Cloudworks** to extend conference deivery & discussion into asynch and open mode
